DIRECTIONS to OACHADO

- Enter the following latitude, longitude decimal GPS coordinates exactly into Google Maps or Waze to plan your route.
- Do not use Apple Maps as it does not correctly accept GPS coordinates.
- Property Access Gate on Coyote Road, Mora County: 36.023909, -105.228181

ROUTE DESCRIPTION

- From Santa Fe at I-25, Oachado is 100 miles or 1 hr / 45 min. I-25 to Las Vegas, NM, exiting onto NM 518 (toward Mora). There are several routes through Las Vegas, the last place for abundant provisions.
- Go north on NM 518 about 25 miles or 30 minutes to turn right onto NM 442 at La Cueva and the old water wheel mill (this turn is 5.3 miles or 7 minutes short of Mora), north toward Ocate. Go 4-1/2 miles to the Rainsville area, passing a logs and firewood business on the right. Continue 1/2 mile to turn left onto gravel Lucero Road (just past mm5 / marked as A021).
- On Lucero Road go 1.6 miles to Lucero, which is a cluster of old buildings where the road jogs right to become Coyote Road. Continue 1/2 mile to Oachado's red 16-foot steel gate on the left, just after Coyote Road dips.
- From the access gate Oachado with parking/camping is a final 1/2 mile.
- Those with really large rigs or coming before Friday **text the property owners at** (580) 919-3241 or -3271.
- Those with long rigs AND a tow-behind trailer, a truck with 2" ball will be available to bring your trailer up separately if you have to use the back-up pad to maneuver through the access gate. Friday afternoon/evening an assistant with a radio at the access gate will be posted to communicate with the owner who will be guiding all coming in to the areas that are most ideal for each rig.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

- Nearest food and fuel from Oachado is Mora, a half hour away.
- Dry camping and no grid power.
- Turning skirt and back-up pad opposite the gate on the county road provided to ease getting the large rigs in. Really large rigs with tow-behind trailers can demount the trailer to have host pull it up if backing up is required to get through the gate.
- The host will guide you to an optimal spot, and may post someone at the gate with a radio on Friday.
- Local cellular signal is 3G and some phones and plans work better than others.
- Please walk your dogs on leash and reduce free roaming in the camping areas.
- Spark arrestors are absolutely required!
- No campfires! Hosts will provide a fire in their social area if conditions allow.
- Remove fuels from around propane fireplaces and abstain from using them when it is dry and windy.
- No medical services are provided! Plan ahead regarding medical facility locations. Oachado is remote! Response of emergency services is not guaranteed and there may be significant delays.
- Bears, snakes, and other wild animals may be present. Parents watch over your kids and please restrain them from repeat pit racing.
- Reminder that ALL attendees must sign the AMA Release & Waiver of Liability (riders, parents, spectators, etc)
